

Normanton Golf Club - Course Closure Policy

Occasionally weather conditions such as snow, frost, fog or rainfall dictate that the golf course should be closed to ensure the Health and Safety of golfers and to protect the long-term conditions of the course. On these occasions the club will adopt the following guidelines:

- When a decision by the Green Staff is made to close the golf course the daily notice to members on the web site, recorded message, twitter and Club V1 will state either:
 - the course is closed for the day or
 - the course is closed at this time and will be further inspected at a stated time.

- Should a re inspection be required then these will be undertaken during the week (Monday – Friday) by the Senior Green Staff on duty and on weekends by either The Professional or the Greens Director.

- If a decision is made to open the course later that day this will be conveyed to members via the web site, recorded message, twitter and Club V1 stating the time from which play will be permitted.

- Members whose pre-booked start times are after the course re-opens will have priority over other members wishing to play later in the day. Anyone wishing to avail themselves of a later start time may either book from the available times on BRS or speak directly with the Pro Shop who will make all reasonable steps to accommodate their wishes.
