Simulator work on-site

It is planned for work to start on site to construct the new building to house the Simulator on 16th August. It is envisaged the work will take a minimum of 8 weeks but could be up to 12 weeks long. The Simulator building is going to be constructed in the recess part of the car park where the current Captains, Disabled and raffle winner bays are, however the contractor will also need use of many of the other parking bays along the fence to store his materials, equipment, etc. and so parking in this part of the car park will be severely restricted during the period of construction. The Disabled bay will be re-allocated and clearly marked for disabled people only. Members need to take care when parking or walking in this area whilst construction is ongoing being mindful that part of the Car Park is a construction site for a period. Full access for the use of buggies will be maintained throughout this period.
