

Where from the 1st May we have standardised par on all the men's tees, which means the Yellow 9th Hole, Red 3rd 9th 14th 15th and Winter 9th 14th all become par 5's (Ladies Tees not affected), much of the work surrounds the handicap system where NGC have a Handicap Committee to ensure we conform to WHS guidelines. The committee also monitors handicaps, looking at scoring trends and result patterns, etc.

A recent volunteer who has just joined the Committee is last year's Club Captain David Ryley. David joins fellow committee members; Bryan Harvey (Chair), Gary Pritchard, Gina Kershaw, Andy Hay and Rich Carter (Advisory).

- We do ask that you wear a pair of **clean** indoor shoes, trainers are ideal, but definitely not outdoor Golf Shoes.
- We also ask that you ensure your clubs are clean with no sign of mud etc. Just give them a quick wash before turning up please.

Ladies Open Day – Thursday 13th June

Format is AM/AM Stableford with the best 2 scores to count. Handicap limit is 36 (Higher handicaps welcome to play but will be capped at 36). Tees available between 09:00 and 14:00 £80 per team of four to include free refreshments at the half way house.

Summer Open Day – Saturday 26th June

Format - Better Ball Stableford, 85% handicap. Maximum shot allowance is 28 (Men) & 36 (Ladies). Tee Times available from 8:36am to 2:28pm. Significant Prize Fund! Catering will be available throughout the day. £20 per player.

AM-AM Open Day – Friday 23rd August

A Team AM-AM event (4 players) open to all Male & Female golfers. Mixed teams are allowed. The format is stableford (85% handicap allowance) with two scores to count on each hole. Gents play off white tees and Ladies off red tees. Entry fee £100 per Team of 4 which includes a Hot breakfast roll and hot drink on arrival, a generous prize pot and a complimentary 2's entry per team. Refreshments also available at our Halfway House. Tees available from 09:00 - 14:00. H/caps will be capped at 28 (Men) and 36 (Ladies) but higher handicapped players can still play.
